INTRODUCTION

The nature of work is changing rapidly, and artificial intelligence is reshaping how people find and secure professional opportunities. Today, job seekers must navigate systems driven by algorithms — from job discovery to applicant tracking systems (ATS) that often determine whether a resume is ever seen by a human reviewer.

This advanced guide was developed at the nonprofit Refraction Innovation Hub as part of our [Community Tuesdays](#) program, which began as a resource for professionals impacted by federal workforce changes and has since expanded to support anyone navigating a career transition or building something new in this environment.

What follows is a practical, field-tested set of tools and strategies designed to help you approach the modern job search more effectively. Whether you are refining your resume, exploring new roles, or preparing for interviews, the goal is to help you engage with today’s hiring landscape in a more informed and intentional way — and to **move forward with confidence**.

2. LinkedIn Job Search: How to Find the Newest Job Opportunities

- **How to Pinpoint the Most Recent Job Postings:** LinkedIn Jobs' "Most Recent" sort does not necessarily guarantee sub-day-level specificity, but modifying the URL on your results page could help track jobs posted within hours or even minutes by fine-tuning the time-based parameters (r86400 = last 24 hours, for example). And savvy job seekers might consider creating bookmarked URLs for hyper-specific, daily-updated searches (e.g., specific company roles, locations, or time filters) to save time.
- **Start by Performing a Job Search:** Go to LinkedIn Jobs:
 - Enter your preferred job title, location, and any other filters (e.g., experience level, remote work).
- **Locate the URL in Your Browser:** After performing the search, look at the URL in your browser. It will look something like this:

- **Add the Recency Filter to the URL:** To narrow the results to the most recently posted jobs, you can modify the URL by adding or editing the following parameter: &f_TPR=r86400
 - Here's what the parameter means: r86400 specifies that you want jobs posted in the last 24 hours (86400 seconds).
 - Example modified URL filtering for jobs posted in the last 24 hours:

- **Fine-Tune It to Get Freshly Posted Jobs (Minutes Ago):** If you need jobs posted more recently (e.g., in the past hour), replace r86400 with smaller time frames:
 - r3600: Last hour (3600 seconds).
 - r1800: Last 30 minutes.
 - Updated URL filtering for jobs posted in the past hour:

- **Press Enter to Reload the Search:** Hit enter after modifying the URL, and LinkedIn will now show only jobs posted within the specified timeframe.

4. AI Certifications: How to Find Opportunities to Demonstrate Technical Literacy

- **General AI & Machine Learning Certifications (Broad Recognition)**

- **Microsoft Certified: Azure AI Fundamentals (AI-900):** Entry-level, no coding required. Covers core AI/ML concepts, responsible AI, and Azure AI services. Good for showing baseline AI literacy.
 - **Google Cloud: AI Essentials or Machine Learning Specialization:** Google offers AI Essentials (non-technical) and more advanced ML Engineer tracks. Well recognized by employers.
 - **IBM Applied AI Professional Certificate (Coursera):** Strong entry-level certification that covers practical AI applications, including chatbots, natural language processing, and using AI in business contexts.
 - **AWS Certified Machine Learning – Specialty:** More advanced; great for those with some tech background. Very credible because of AWS’s dominance.
- **Practical AI-in-Business Certifications (Workplace Ready)**
 - **Generative AI Certification by Google (via Coursera):** Introductory and job-market relevant. Focuses on prompt engineering, generative AI tools, and use cases.’
 - **Stanford Online: AI in Healthcare, Business, and Society (Coursera/edX):** Strong reputation, non-technical, focused on applied use of AI across industries.
 - **LinkedIn Learning AI Certificates:** Shorter, stackable credentials that emphasize AI in productivity, business decision-making, and prompt engineering. Easy for recruiters to see on LinkedIn profiles.
 - **Specialized “Hot Topic” Certifications (Signals Awareness of Trends)**
 - **Prompt Engineering for ChatGPT (Coursera, DeepLearning.AI + OpenAI):** Popular certification that shows ability to effectively use LLMs for real-world tasks.
 - **DataCamp / edX: AI for Everyone (Andrew Ng):** Non-technical, but highly regarded. Signals AI literacy and adaptability.
 - **Certified Ethical Emerging Technologist (CET) – CertNexus:** Focused on ethics, governance, and responsible AI — increasingly valued by employers.

5. Custom-Built AI Prompt: How to Quickly Tailor Your Resume for Every New Job Posting

- **Why Updating Your Resume for Each Job Opportunity Is Essential:** Today, job seekers need to tailor their resumes for each job posting because customizing the content to match specific job requirements, keywords, and company needs significantly increases their chances of passing through applicant tracking systems (ATS) and catching the attention of hiring managers.
- **A Sample AI Prompt:** To help you with that updating process, simply provide a copy of your resume and the relevant job description to your AI assistant of choice (e.g., ChatGPT, Claude, or Gemini), and use the following prompt to get the assistant started on your new, job-specific resume:
 - **Refraction’s Current Resume-Revising Prompt:** You are a top-tier career consultant specializing in ATS resume optimization and tailored resume editing. My goal is to perfectly align my resume (attached here) with the job description I have provided (included after these instructions), optimizing it for ATS best practices while maintaining professionalism, coherent language, and avoiding all fabrications.

■ **(1) For Context:**

- (1.a) Resume (See Attached File): My resume contains my current experience, skills, and accomplishments. Use it as the foundation to craft the most compelling and ATS-friendly version of my application.

6. Advanced AI Resume Techniques: How to Use a Multi-Step AI Approach to Beat ATS Filters

- **How to Gain a Greater Degree of Confidence After Using an Initial AI Prompt:** Start by updating your resume for a specific job posting using Refraction’s AI Prompt above to prepare a job-specific resume.
- **Use an ATS-Friendly Resume Template:** Commonly used resume formats and features often create problems for the ATS tools that are scanning applicant’s resumes. Remove any uncertainty about your own resume by taking the content of your new resume produced by Refraction’s resume prompt and then incorporating it into one of Jobscan’s free, ATS-friendly resume templates found on the following Jobscan page: <https://www.jobscan.co/resume-templates/ats-templates>
- **Grade Your Resume to Beat the Standard ATS Cutoff Scores:** Many modern employers use Applicant Tracking Systems (ATS) to automatically screen resumes before they reach a human recruiter. These systems compare the language of a resume to the job description, generating a “match rate” that estimates how well an applicant’s qualifications align with the role. Industry sources consistently recommend aiming for a minimum match rate of 75% or higher to advance past automated filters. According to [Jobscan](#), resumes meeting this threshold are significantly more likely to be reviewed by recruiters. [TechRSeries](#) and [ResuFit](#) likewise report that a score of **70–80%** indicates strong alignment with the role and a greater chance of reaching the next stage of consideration. One of the leading resume-grading tools on the market is Jobscan, which lets website visitors get a limited number of free resume scores before requiring them to upgrade to a paid account: <https://www.jobscan.co/resume-score>. Briefly stated, this is how you can achieve that optimal match rate:
 - **Step One - Upload Your New AI-Optimized Resume and Job Description to Jobscan:** Start by uploading your new resume, which should contain the new content generated by Refraction’s AI prompt in an ATS-friendly resume template, to Jobscan to get your initial score. Please note that Jobscan’s scoring system is relative, which means that you will need to include a copy of the description of the job you are applying for to begin the scanning process. If your initial score falls below the 70% threshold, then proceed to Step Two below.
 - **Step Two - Return to ChatGPT for Additional Assistance:** Create a PDF copy of your initial Jobscan report – either the full version if you are a Jobscan subscriber or the partial version if you are using the free version of Jobscan – and go back to ChatGPT and upload the Jobscan report.
 - **If You Have a Jobscan Subscription:** If you have access to your full Jobscan report as a Jobscan subscriber, then simply use the following prompt in ChatGPT: “Please analyze the

attached Jobscan report and produce a new version of my resume (pasted below) that addresses all of the red X's in the attached report without any fabrications." Then paste a text-only version of your resume beneath that prompt.

- **If You Only Have a Free Jobscan Account:** If you only have a partial Jobscan report as a free user, then use the following ChatGPT prompt: "Please analyze the partial Jobscan report attached here and produce a new version of my resume (pasted below) that addresses any problems identified by the Jobscan report – without fabrications, please. My objective is to ensure that my new resume gets a Jobscan score of at least 70-80%." Then paste a text-only version of your resume beneath that prompt.
- **Step Three - Return to Jobscan to Get a New Score:** Go back to Jobscan with your new resume and the relevant job description to get a new score. If your new resume falls below the 70-80% threshold, then repeat Step Two to determine if further incremental improvements can be made.
